MONROVIA, Liberia — The Ministry of Education congratulates all University of Liberia students who have been cleared for graduation.

The 98th Commencement Exercises runs from Monday, December 4-13, 2017 at the University's Fendell Campus. Overall, 3,050 students are expected to graduate from the undergraduate colleges while the graduate and professional schools will produce 371 graduates.

The Ministry especially commends the valedictorian for the Undergraduate Colleges, Julia Vessellee (GPA: 3.757), who will graduate Summa Cum Laude in Public Administration from the A. Romeo Horton College of Business and Public Administration. Also commended is the valedictorian for the Graduate and Professional Schools, Justice N. Timah (GPA: 3.786), of the Kofi Annan Institute for Conflict Transformation.
